Important information for Essendine Primary School Nursery places September

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for your application for a place at Essendine Nursery.

From September 2018 funding for early education for 3 and 4 year old children at Essendine primary School is changing.

All families with a 3 and 4 year old child will still be eligible for the universal offer of free early education of up to 15 hours a week term time or a total of 570 hours taken throughout the year.

This means your child will only attend part-time - attending either the morning or afternoon sessions

Some children will be eligible for extended childcare from this date, which is up to 30 hours per week term time.

Here at Essendine we are happy to announce we are able to offer a significant number of 30 hours places to those children entitled to it!

If you are interested and think you may be entitled please follow the local authority guidance below.

You will be eligible for 30hours if the criteria below apply to you:

- both parents must be working (or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family), and each parent earns a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage or living wage, and less than £100,000 per year.
- working will include employed and self-employed persons.
- in general families where one parent does not work (or neither parent works) will not be eligible for these additional hours.
- both parents are employed but one or both parents is temporarily away from the workplace on parental, maternity or paternity leave.
- both parents are employed but one or both parents is temporarily away from the workplace on adoption leave.
- both parents are employed but one or both parents is temporarily away from the workplace on statutory sick pay.
- one parent is employed and one parent has substantial caring responsibilities based on specific benefits received for caring or one parent is employed and one parent is disabled or incapacitated based on receipt of specific benefits.
